Duration of Examination

A question paper for theory examinations of any course program is of 3 hours duration, depending upon the associated credit unit, withmaximum marks 70/35 as applicable.

Format of Question Paper

The question papers for the End Semester Examinations shall be set in such a manner as to ensure that they cover the entire syllabus as per the concerned course unit. Question Paper has 2 sections:

Section A: The questions in this section include short numerical problems or theory questions to assess students' understanding of concepts and framework. This section have multiple questions as per guidelines and students have to attempt as per instructions given in the question paper. Marks are given as per the weightage given to the Section in overall marking scheme.

Section B: The questions in this section may include long theory questions or numerical problems requiring students to apply the concepts to a given situation or in a given context. This section also have multiple questions and marks are given as per the weightage given to the Section in overall marking scheme.

Question papers of "Value Addition Courses" may have different format. The paper setters gives wider choice to the students for answering questions, by providing alternate questions in each of the sections of the question paper. The total option in a question paper is not more than 350% of the total marks assigned to a question paper.
