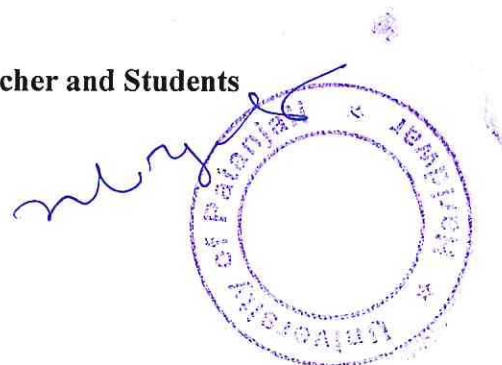

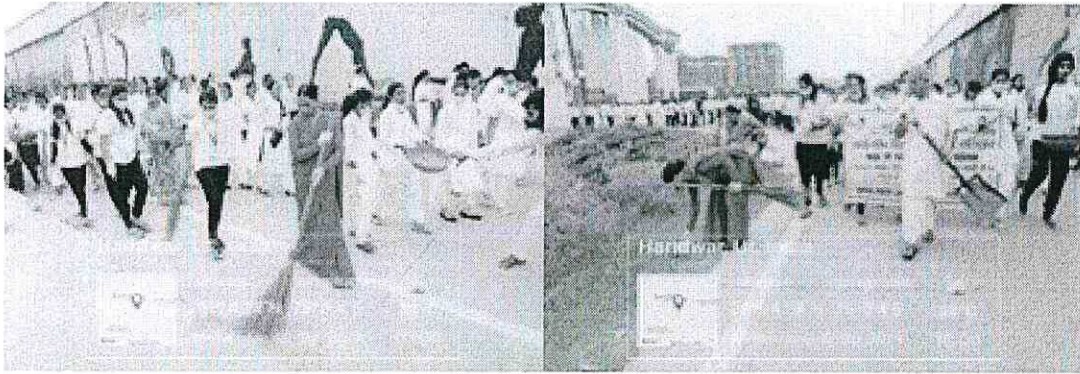

A brief report on;

Cleanliness Awareness Program and Cleaning by B.Sc. Yoga Science, 1st Year students - passage to Chandi Mandir, Haridwar

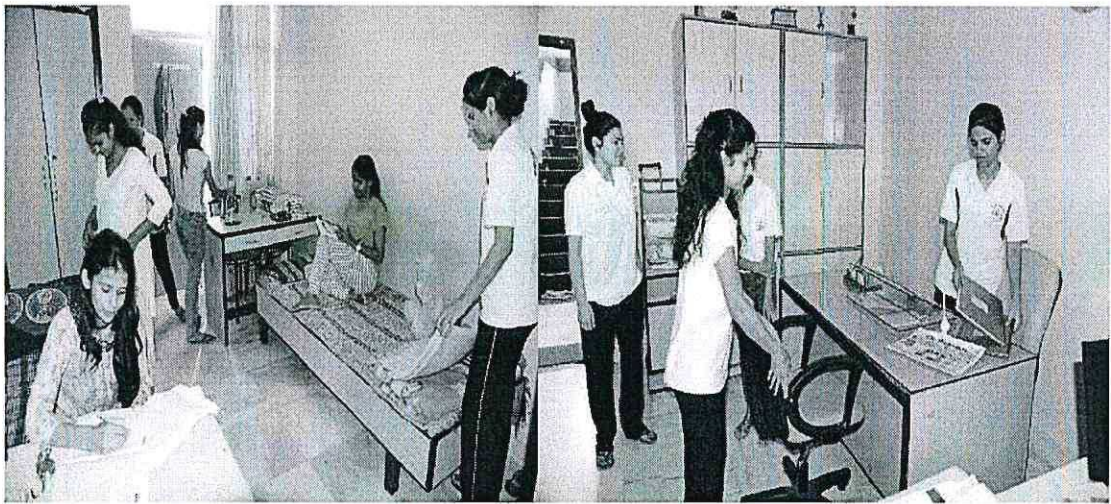

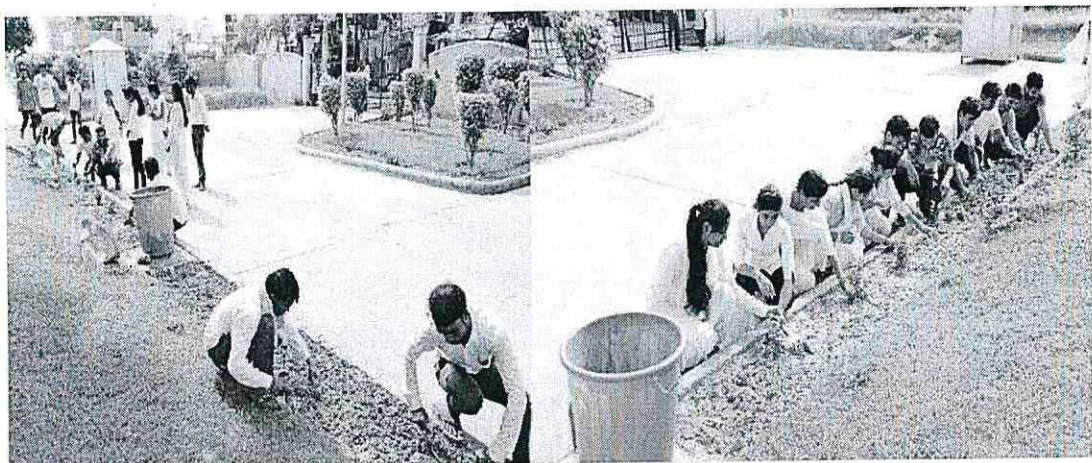

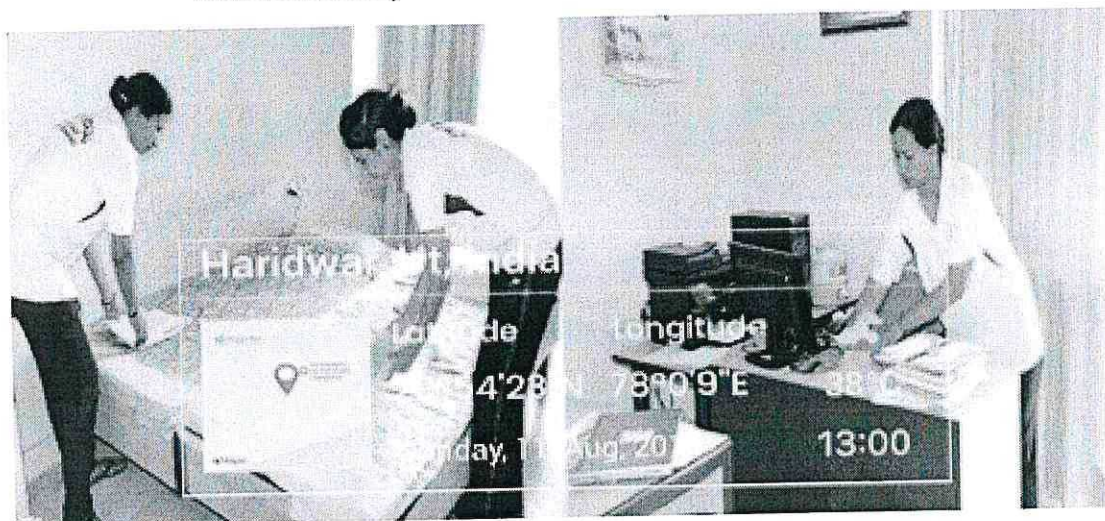

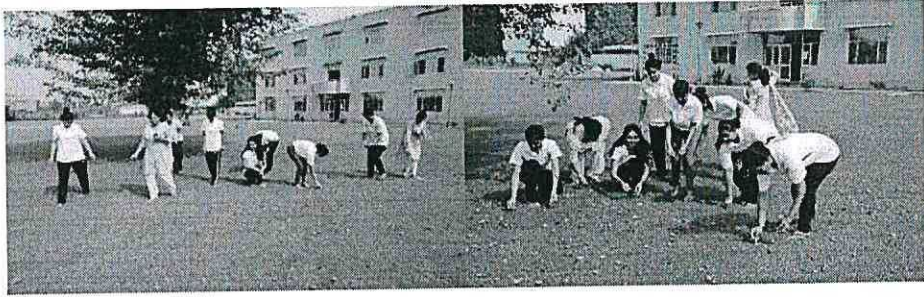

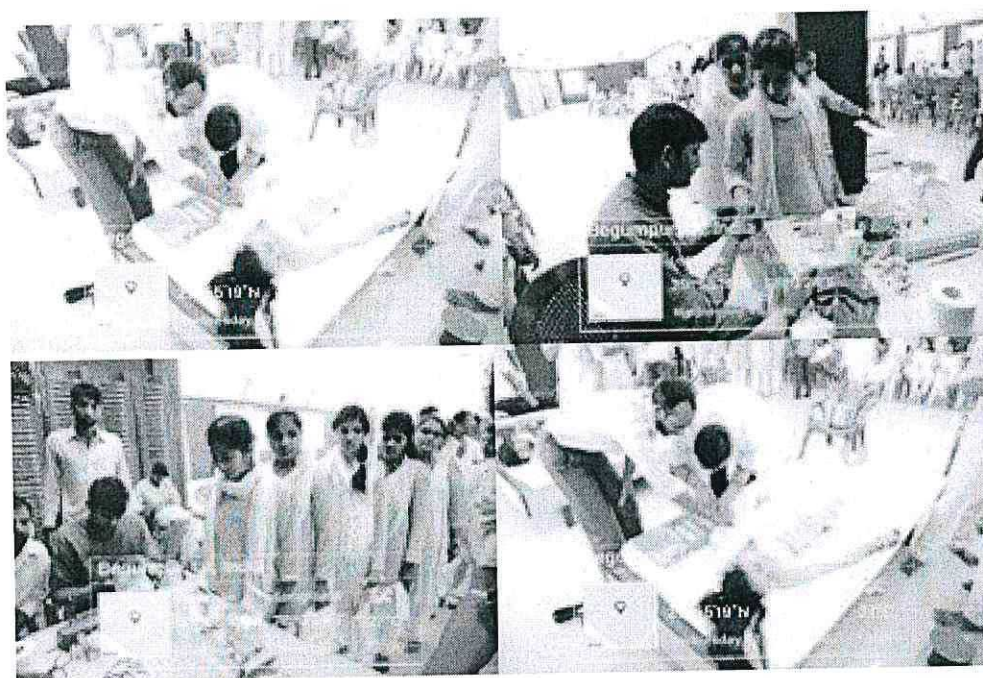

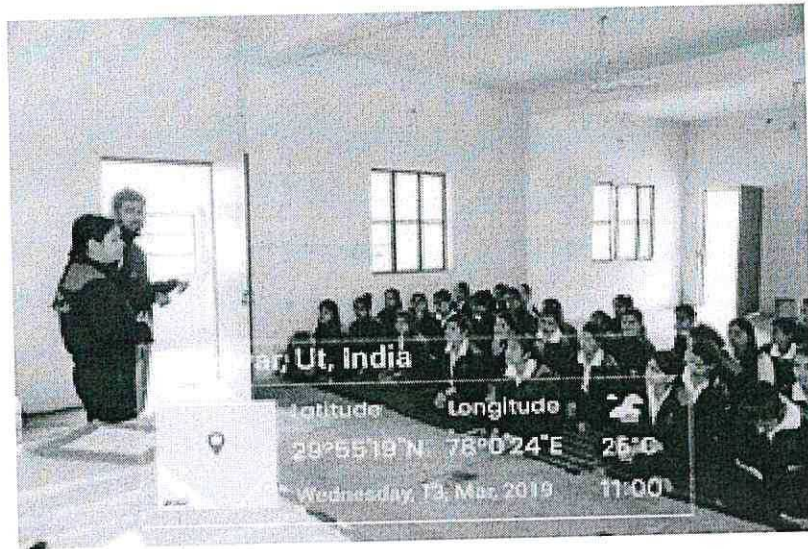

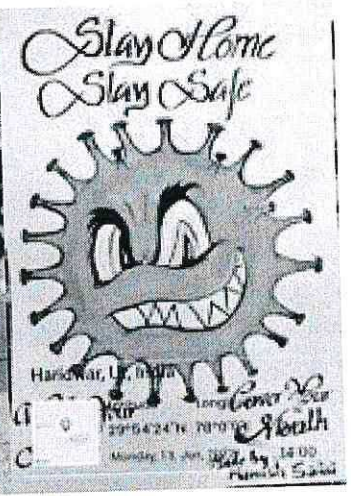
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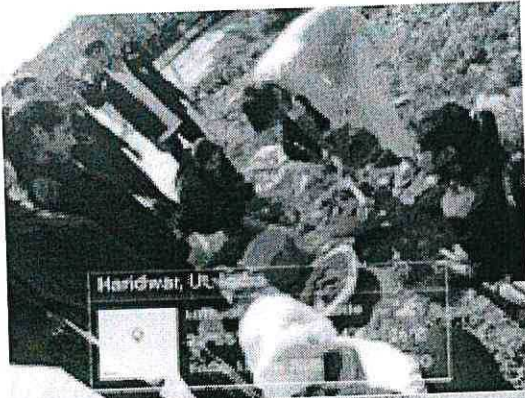
